The Great Experiment...Gone Horribly Wrong

Moving the net time one hour later just didn't pan out. In order to get good propagation in the summer we would need to go 2 or even 3 hours later. It doesn't get dark here until almost 10PM at the solstice, and that's what is required, to follow the Sun. I also made the change too fast, which caused a lot of confusion. It has been tried before, but this should affirm that it's not worth it, and that it's more desireable to have a reliable net time. Thanks to everyone for trying it, especially the Net Control Stations.
